Important Information for the March 2, 2021 City of Sanibel Regular Election

Lee County, FL (Friday, January 29, 2021) The City of Sanibel Regular Election is Tuesday, March 2, 2021.

The residents of the City of Sanibel have until Monday, February 1, 2021, to register to vote and be eligible to participate in their Tuesday, March 2, 2021, Regular Election.

The deadline to request a Vote-by-Mail ballot is 5 p.m. Saturday, February 20. For information to request and return a ballot, voters may call our office at 239-533-8683 or visit our website lee.vote.

All Vote-by-Mail ballots must be returned to the Lee County Supervisor of Elections Office by 7:00 p.m., Election Day, Tuesday, March 2, 2021. Voters may check the status of their Vote-by-Mail ballots on our website here <https://www.lee.vote/Admin/Check-my-Registration-Status>.

The Canvassing Board will meet to conduct the testing of the voting machines and tabulating equipment to be used in the precincts and for tabulating mail ballots on Wednesday, February 10,
