November 8, General Election Canvassing Board Meetings and Logic and Accuracy Testing Schedule

Lee County, FL (October 10, 2022) The Lee County Supervisor of Elections will test, by a random method of selection, a percentage of the voting machines used in the November General Election. The Logic and Accuracy Test will take place at 9:00 a.m., Wednesday, October 12, at the Lee County Elections Office in the Melvin Morgan Constitutional Complex, 2480 Thompson Street, 3rd floor, Fort Myers. The Canvassing Board will then canvass the Vote-by-Mail Ballots received to date for the General Election.

In Florida, an elections Canvassing Board is responsible for overseeing all public pretesting of a sample of the tabulation equipment used in an election (also known as Logic and Accuracy Testing), examining ballots or groups of ballots, determining voter intent (when required by law), compiling election returns, conducting recounts (when required by law), determining the official results of an election, certifying an election, and conducting post-election manual audits in order to check voting system performance.
