Lee County Elections will conduct Logic & Accuracy Testing of Voting Equipment for the Presidential Preference Primary Election.

Lee County, FL (February 15, 2024) Lee County Elections will conduct the Logic and Accuracy Testing (L&A) of the voting equipment to be used in the March 19 Presidential Preference Primary Election. The L&A will take place on **Wednesday**, **February 21**, at 9 a.m., at the Melvin Morgan Constitutional Complex, located at 2480 Thompson St., 3rd Floor, Fort Myers.

Equipment to be tested includes Early Voting, Election Day and Vote-by-Mail Ballot tabulation equipment, pursuant to Florida Statute 101.5612.

Testing is conducted to ensure ballots are printed correctly and that the voting system is counting votes correctly. It will be overseen by the County Canvassing Board, composed of a county judge, a county commissioner, and the supervisor of elections.

On **Friday, February 23, at 9 a.m.**, the Canvassing Board will convene to canvass Vote-by-Mail Ballots received to date for the election.

The Canvassing Board meetings and Logic and Accuracy Testing are open to the public. A complete schedule is available on the <u>Lee County Elections website</u>.
