Lee County Elections will begin mailing Vote-by-Mail Ballots for the 2024 Presidential Preference Primary Election.

Lee County, FL (February 6, 2024) Lee County Elections will begin its initial mailing of domestic Vote-by-Mail Ballots for the Presidential Preference Primary (PPP) on **Tuesday, February 13**. Approximately 53,000 Vote-by-Mail Ballots will be mailed to voters who requested one for the March 19 PPP.

Voters who have not submitted a Vote-by-Mail request to our office since the 2022 General Election will need to submit a new request to receive a Vote-by-Mail Ballot for the 2024 elections. Requests can be made by calling (239) 533-8683 or online at www.lee.vote.

Once requested, voters can track their Vote-by-Mail Ballot using <u>BallotTrax</u>. This free service provides notifications to voters on the status of their ballot via text, phone, and email.

Deadline to request a Vote-by-Mail Ballot:

• 5:00 P.M., Thursday, March 7, 2024

Deadline to return a Vote-by-Mail Ballot:

7:00 P.M., Election Day, Tuesday, March 19, 2024

Hand-delivered ballots may be dropped off at any of the <u>Lee County Elections' offices</u>, Monday through Friday, from 8:30 A.M. to 5:00 P.M., or on Election Day, from 8:30 A.M. to 7:00 P.M.

A voter may also drop off their Vote-by-Mail Ballot at an authorized Secure Ballot Intake Station, located at every Early Voting site, during Early Voting from Saturday, March 9, through Saturday, March 16, 10 A.M. to 6 P.M., daily.
