**LEE COUNTY SUPERVISOR OF ELECTIONS REMINDS VOTERS:  
NO PRECINCT VOTING IN LEE COUNTY  
ON ELECTION DAY, TUESDAY, NOVEMBER 8**

**Lee County, FL (November 2, 2022)** Lee County Supervisor of Elections Tommy Doyle reminds voters there will not be any precinct voting on Election Day, Tuesday, November 8.

Due to the impact of Hurricane Ian, numerous Election Day polling places in Lee County are unavailable. As a result, Lee County's 12 Early Voting sites will be open on Election Day and will replace traditional polling place voting on Tuesday, November 8.

Voters may vote at any of the 12 available voting sites during Early Voting or on Election Day, regardless of their assigned precinct. Supervisor of Elections Tommy Doyle says, "I strongly encourage voters to vote now during the Early Voting period. Long lines are expected if voters wait to cast their vote on Election Day."

**November 8 General Election Voting Hours:**

- Today through Monday, November 7: 9:00 AM to 6:00 PM, daily
- Election Day, Tuesday, November 8: 7:00 AM to 7:00 PM
