**Lee County Elections To Add Secure Ballot Intake Station
At Dunbar-Jupiter Hammon Public Library**

Lee County, FL (November 3, 2022) Lee County Elections will add a Secure Ballot Intake Station (formerly known as a drop box) at the Dunbar-Jupiter Hammon Public Library for voters in nearby communities who wish to drop off their Vote-by-Mail Ballot in person.

The Secure Ballot Intake Station will be located at 3095 Blount St. in Fort Myers. It will be monitored by staff and available on Sunday, November 6, and Monday, November 7, from 9:00 A.M. to 6:00 P.M.

On Election Day, Tuesday, November 8, voters who wish to drop off their Vote-by-Mail Ballot must do so at an office of the Lee County Supervisor of Elections only, from 8:30 A.M. to 7:00 P.M. For a list of office locations, please visit <https://www.lee.vote/Contact-Us>.

A Vote-by-Mail ballot received after 7:00 p.m. on November 8, 2022, is ineligible to be counted.
