## Third-Party Organization Voter Registration Mailings

**Lee County, FL (March 16, 2022)** The Voter Participation Center (VPC) and the Center for Voter Information (CVI) will begin mailing voter registration applications to Florida residents around Thursday, March 17.

Our office has been notified that over 12,000 Lee County residents will receive these mailings regarding their voter registration status. The VPC and CVI organizations are not affiliated with the Lee County Supervisor of Elections Office.

The VPC and CVI make it clear to mail recipients that the mailing comes from a non-government organization. The mailings include a letter from Tom Lopach, President of VPPC, or Gail Kitch, Board Chair of CVI, urging citizens to register to vote.
