Vote-by-Mail Deadlines for the March 19 Presidential Preference Primary Election

Lee County, FL (March 4, 2024) Lee County Supervisor of Elections, Tommy Doyle, reminds voters that the last day to request a Vote-by-Mail Ballot for the March 19 Presidential Preference Primary Election is 5 p.m., Thursday, March 7. Voters can request their ballot by calling (239) 533-8683 or online at www.lee.vote.

The deadline to return a Vote-by-Mail Ballot to the Lee County Supervisor of Elections is 7 p.m., on Election Day, Tuesday, March 19.

If returning a ballot by mail, we recommend mailing it no later than Tuesday, March 12, to ensure timely receipt.

Hand-delivered ballots may be dropped off at any of the [Lee County Elections' offices](#), Monday through Friday, from 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., or on Election Day, from 8:30 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.

Voters may also drop off their Vote-by-Mail Ballots at an authorized Secure Ballot Intake Station, located at every Early Voting site during Early Voting, Saturday, March 9, through Saturday, March 16, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., daily.
