MONDAY, JULY 30TH IS VOTER REGISTRATION AND POLITICAL PARTY AFFILIATION CHANGE DEADLINE FOR AUGUST 28TH PRIMARY ELECTION

Lee County, FL (July 12, 2018) The deadline to register to vote or change political party affiliation for the August 28, 2018, Primary Election is Monday, July 30, 2018. If you are not already registered to vote in Lee County, you must be registered 29 days before an election to be eligible to vote in that election. If you are already registered to vote in Lee County, a political party change must be made 29 days before an election in order for the change to be effective for that election.

Lee County voters can confirm their voter record in the Voter Resources tab on our website lee.vote and click [Check my Voter Registration Status](#) or call the Supervisor of Elections Office (239) LEE-VOTE (533-8683). Questions regarding the eligibility of those who are not currently registered to vote may also be directed to these sources.
