Early Voting Information for August 28th Primary Election

Lee County, FL (August 10, 2018) Early Voting for the Primary Election will begin Saturday, August 18, 2018 and continue through Saturday, August 25th 2018. Early Voting sites will be open daily, including Sunday, August 19th, from 10:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m.

Prepare to vote in the Primary Election ahead of time- mark your sample ballot and bring it with you when you vote.

In order to vote in person at an Early Voting site or at your polling place on Election Day, you are required to provide an acceptable form of picture and signature identification. If your picture identification does not include your signature, you may provide any form of signature identification. Signature identification does not have to be current.

Acceptable picture identifications:

- Florida Driver's License
- Florida Identification Card (issued by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles)
- United States Passport
- Debit or Credit Card
- Military Identification
- Student Identification
- Retirement Center Identification
- Public Assistance Identification
- Veteran Health ID (issued by the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs)
- Florida Concealed Weapon License (issued pursuant to s. 790.06 FS)
- Government Employee ID
