## **Tuesday, October 9<sup>th</sup> is the Voter Registration Deadline for General Election**

**Lee County, FL (September 17, 2018)** The deadline to register to vote or change your party affiliation is Tuesday, October 9, 2018 for the November 6, 2018 General Election. Florida law requires Florida residents must be registered to vote or make a party affiliation change 29 days before an election. All registered voters may vote in a General Election regardless of party affiliation.

To register to vote you must use a Florida Voter Registration Application or use the Online Voter Registration to submit an application and update an existing registration. To submit an online application, you will need your Florida driver license (Florida DL) or Florida identification card (Florida ID card) issued by the Florida Department of Highway Safety & Motor Vehicles. Online Voter Registration has multiple safeguards in place to verify and protect a person's identity and personal information.

If you would prefer not to utilize Online Voter Registration, you may print out a blank Florida Voter Registration Application and return it in person at one of our four office locations, or by mail. If you choose to return your Florida Voter Registration Application by mail, send to :
